MINUTES OF the 17th MEETING of the APEX COMMITTEE

The meeting was taken by the Chief Secretary on 11.09.12 at 4:00 PM in the Conference Hall, Secretariat, Jaipur. The list of participants is at Annexure 1.

The agenda note was circulated previously and the record of discussions held during the meeting is as follows:

1. Confirmation of minutes

As no comments were received from any of the members present at the previous meeting, the minutes of the 16th meeting were approved.

2. Action taken report

Secretary, IT&C apprised the committee of the action taken regarding the decisions of the previous meeting.

- a. On the subject of e-mail services being provided to all the government officers by DoIT&C through NIC's eamil server, Chief Secretary directed that efforts be made to popularise and publicise the official e-mail services for optimum use.
- b. Regarding usage of RGDPS MIS portal, Chief Secretary directed that AR Department may decide a cut-off date from which manual MIS reports will not be acceptable by the Department. All the departments will have to upload the MIS through RDGPS portal only.

3. Review of the expenditure against the budget provision under IT/ e-governance for:

a. Higher Education Department

Special Secretary, Higher Education apprised the Committee of the status of expenditure against the budget provision for IT / e-governance and assured that the funds will be utilised by the end of the current financial year 2012-13.

b. School Education Department

Principal Secretary – IT&C apprised the Committee, as per the agenda note, about the status of expenditure against the budget provision for IT / e-governance. The Committee was informed about the change in the scheme for providing tablets to the school students to provisioning of laptops to the students. The change has been approved by the Government and the scheme is now to be implemented as per the revised approvals. The Committee was assured of implementation of the scheme within the current financial year.

4. Revenue Department: Roll out of web-based Apna Khata

Registrar, Board of Revenue, informed the Committee about the status of web-enabled Apna Khata project. It was decided that BOR will ensure delivery of online

jamabandis in at least one tehsil in each district latest by 1st November 2012 and in all the tehsils by the end of this year.

5. Enhancement of service basket under CSC /e-Mitra Project

Secretary – IT&C apprised the Committee about the current status of service delivery through CSC / e-Mitra kiosks, as per the agenda note and about the proposal to enhance CSC/e-Mitra service basket by making fee deposition mandatory through CSC / eMitra kiosks only for:

- a. Recruitments in all the government departments and PSUs
- b. Admissions to courses like R-PMT, R-PET, R-MAT etc. in all government institutions

In view of the similar procedure adopted by RPSC for all the exams being conducted by the RPSC, having done away with other methods for collection / deposition of requisite fees, the Committee approved the proposal and directed that a circular be issued under the signatures of Chief Secretary.

6. Citizen Contact Centre.

Secretary – IT&C apprised the Committee about the Citizen Contact Centre as per the agenda note. The Committee was informed that the project will not be funded by Government of India, as previously informed, as the proposal has been turned down by the Planning Commission. Therefore, the project is now to be executed from the State funds. The project will be executed through RISL.

It was pointed out that the service charges are not as per rates approved by FD. The project was given administrative and financial sanction with revision in RISL service charges with the cost break-up, for two years, as follows:

SIO-NIC was directed to submit a proposal to DoIT&C for the same.

8. PMU constitution for LSG

The requirement of a PMU for the 'e-Nagar Mitra' project was informed to the Committee, as per the agenda note, by the Principal Secretary – UDH. The PMU is to be set up for a period of five years at the following cost:
