**MINUTES OF 13<sup>th</sup> MEETING of the APEX COMMITTEE**

The meeting was taken by the Chief Secretary on 25.01.12 at 4.00 PM in Committee Room no. 1, Secretariat, Jaipur. The list of participants is enclosed.

Record of discussions held during the meeting is as follows:

**1. Confirmation of minutes**

As no comments were received from any of the members present at the previous meeting, the minutes of that meeting were approved.

**2. At the outset, Secretary – IT&C briefed the Committee about the status of the e-Procurement project. It was informed that till date 253 tenders of total value Rs. 81810.64 Lacs have been processed through e-procurement system and training has been imparted to approx 792 officers / officials of different stakeholder departments and 200+ representatives of various bidders.**

The project was appreciated by the Committee.

**3. Action taken report**

Secretary, IT&C apprised the committee of the action taken regarding the decisions of the previous meeting.

**4. IT enablement of Prison Department (Jails) - Phase II through NIC.**

Director General – Jails informed the Committee about the activities undertaken in Phase I of the project. He further informed the Committee about the second phase of the project as detailed in the agenda note.

The Committee approved the following modules under Phase II:

- Prison inmates information system under Prison Management System
- Visitor Management system under prison management system
- Jail Hospital Management system

Regarding the File & Letter Monitoring System and PIS, it was directed that the modules being developed under e-Secretariat may be replicated for Jails also.

- (i) administrative and financial approval of Rs. 7.22 Crores for the project
- (ii) approval to get the work executed from NIC / NICSI without tender; and
- (iii) approval to make an advance payment of Rs. 4.00 Crores to NIC / NICSI from DoIT&C's backend budget head.

#### 5. IT enablement of Tourism Department

The Committee was briefed about the project as per the details given in the agenda note. The Committee was also informed that the project cost is as follows:

The Committee accorded administrative & financial approval to the project for total cost Rs. 180.00 Lacs as per the above table.

#### 6. Computerisation of Department of Social Justice and Empowerment (DoSJ&E), Government of Rajasthan

Principal Secretary, Social Justice & Empowerment Department apprised the Committee about the project as per the agenda note. It was informed that the project will be implemented in phased manner.

The 1<sup>st</sup> Phase will be implemented within 1 year and will include:

- Application development
- Data Digitization (22.80 Lacs documents)
- Rajasthan State Data Center (RSDC) Infrastructure
- Head Office Infrastructure
- Infrastructure for 1 District Office and all of its Block offices

- Training to departmental officials
- Deployment of 7 technical personnel
- Deployment of requisite bandwidth.

The Committee was informed that the total project cost, including 2% contingency and RISL Service charges, is as under:
