Minutes of 82nd meeting of SeMT dated 08-01-2021

The following was discussed in the meeting:

1. Project : Hiring of Consultants/ Expert man-power services

The Committee was informed about the project proposal. Dept. of IT&C intended to hire the expert manpower (consultants) service for various e-Governance Projects executed by DoIT&C/ RISL as mentioned below:

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Observations of the Committee:

Regarding the hiring of Consultant/ Expert manpower services; Chairman, SeMT directed:

- a) For Project- I; the proposal was deferred by the Committee and RajCOMP Info Services Ltd. (RISL) was advised to amend its Administrative Order issued vide No. F4.13 (18)/ RISL/ Tech/ 2019/ 8987 dated 30-06-2020.
- b) For Projects (II, III, IV and V); these proposals shall be put-up on a separate file for approval of Principal Secretary, IT&C.

The Committee directed to comply the above mentioned observations/ direction.

3. Project : Availability of Internet Connection facility in all the Tribal Hostels and Residential Schools pertaining under purview of TAD Dept., Udaipur

The Committee was informed about the proposal. It was also informed that earlier this proposal was taken in 80th meeting of SeMT held on 10-09-2020. It was decided in the 80th meeting of SeMT that (a) Departmental Team of T.A.D. Dept. may review the Project proposal with Commissioner, Dept. of IT&C and Director (Technical), RajCOMP Info Services Ltd. (RISL), Principal Secretary, T.A.D. Dept., and (b) Department will re-submit the proposal accordingly for technical approval of SeMT/ Dept. of IT&C.

In compliance to the same; Dept. of IT&C/ RISL reviewed/ evaluated the project proposal and submitted a "Comparative action plan for internet connectivity at Tribal Hostels of TAD Dept., Udaipur" as mentioned below:

 Advantage of DoIT&C proposal

1. High internet speed for the sites with FTTH and LAN connectivity.
2. Cost saving of approx. Rs. 2.64 Crore.
3. Single point contact (RISL) in case of any issue.



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Financial Implication:

Total estimated cost of proposal is Rs. 514.75 Lakh (excluding Service charges and GST).

Fund Management:

Expenditure would be met from funds available with Tribal Area Development (TAD) Dept.

Observation:

As the Comparative Action Plan provided by Network Team, the proposal suggested by Dept. of IT&C/ RISL seems reasonable and comparatively lesser than TAD Dept.

The Committee accords approval on the proposal having estimated cost of Rs. 514.75 Lakh (excluding Service charges and GST); subject to the funds availability and approval of funds from Finance Department.

4. Project : Proposal for "Redesigning, Web development Maintenance, Content Management, Translation of Contents of websites and web application" for the financial year 2020-21 to 2022-23.

The Committee was briefed about the project proposal. RISL has developed and maintained 40+ integrated portals (comprising 600+ micro portals and 35+ independent websites of various Government Department/ PSUs/ Boards/ Organizations. The development, maintenance, redesigning of websites are continuous process. The daily activity involve patching of security threats and vulnerabilities, updation and modification of modules as per requirements, server migration and server health checks, content updation, integration of payment interface and so on.

Financial Implication:

The details of the estimated cost for the project for the period of financial year 2020-21 to 2022-23 is as under:

Fund Management:

Expenditure would be met from the fund available with Dept. of IT&C under the Budget Head of "Development & Maintenance of website project".

The Committee accords approval of the project with estimated project cost of Rs. 600.00 Lakh for the period of financial year 2020-21 to financial year 2022-23; subject to the funds availability and approval of funds from Finance Dept.



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The Chairman also made few observations and accordingly issued directions as follows:

1. It has been observed that departments send their computer hardware requirement to DoIT&C in compliance to Rule 32 of GF&AR Part-II i.e. "Departments will require approval of DoIT&C for IT/e-Governance related projects above Rs. 25.00 lacs".
2. This has been directed in the meeting that procurement of ICT equipment like Desktop Computers, Laptops, Printers, Multi-Function Printers (MFPs), UPSs, allied items etc. for routine work of office, for implementation of any project, addition of Hardware for expansion of rollout, establishment of computer labs, proposals of Computer Based Exams services, and small network equipment like switch, router, Wi-Fi equipment etc. which are used to establish for building network **are not be considered under the category of IT/ e-Governance Project** as it is merely the procurement of computer hardware/ services.
3. Submit the proposal to Finance Dept. for amendment in Rule 32 of GF&AR Part-II; in light of the directions given in point no. 2 above.

Meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.


