





- Standard/ Terminology and placement of terms

Content Management


- The web content is entirely different from that of the print and audio-visual media and needs special care for drafting. The web content can serve multiple purposes and can be both brief as well as detailed. The Website content should be developed to enable maximum public interface and it should facilitate the citizen of the state in getting information about various schemes, procedure, policies and rules & regulation of the Government.
- Nodal Officer (IT) will be responsible for overall supervision to ensure that authentic, correct and updated information is published on the website.





Content Management

- For the content development, the site maps for navigation of the site is the first and foremost requirement and should be prepared in the first place.
- All department websites **should** have a simplified mechanism for the publication of content on websites allowing content creators to create, edit and update information without requiring technical knowledge /skills required by web application developers such as programming and markup languages.

Contact Directory

Government of India has prescribed a format for Contact directories so that the data can be pooled in central database on the national portal and information retrieval is easy for the users.

The contact directory file should not be in pdf/word/excell format. It should only be a HTML page using table format. May please also ensure that the contact directory has a link on home page of the portal.

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Website Monitoring

Websites must be monitored periodically to address and fix the quality and compatibility issues around the following parameters:

- a) Performance/Site Download time*
- b) Functionality*
- c) Broken links*
- d) Traffic analysis*
- e) User feedbacks*

A review meeting for the same should be conducted every quarter under the chairmanship of department's Nodal Officer / Public Information Officer.



Website Monitoring

- **Validation & Testing**
- Websites should be validated and tested with automatic tools and human review.
- Test with multiple browsers and different version of browsers

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History

It is not on the record as how the name of Bhilwara was ascribed to the which now forms the district Bhilwara. Tradition has it that it came to be known as Bhilwara because it was mostly inhabited by Bhils in old days. These Bhils were eventually driven away towards the hilly tracts and interior places of less importance by the ancestors of the peasant settlers. Ironically enough ,now very few Bhils live in this area. Another version recounts that the present Bhilwara city had a mint where coins known as 'BHILADI' were minted and from this denomination was derived the name of the district. Over the years it has emerged out as the TEXTILE CITY of Rajasthan. Now a days ,Bhilwara is better known as the textile city in the country.

Location

The district Bhilwara is situated between 25°.00' to 27°.50' North Latitude and 74°.03' to 75°.25' East longitude. It is bounded in the north by Ajmer District, in the north-west, west and south west by Udaipur and Rajasamand district. In the south and south south-east by chittorgarh district. In the east and north east by Bundi and Tonk districts. The total length of the district from west to east is 144 km. while the breadth from North to south is 104 km approximately.

Climate

The District Bhilwara has a hot dry summer and bracing cold winter. The cold season is from December to February and is followed by hot summers from March to the last week of June. The south west Monsoon season which follows, last till about mid September. The period from mid September to about the end of November constitutes the post monsoon season.
