**Office Order**

As part of implementation of Rajasthan eGovernance Framework, the Department has implemented Raj SewaDhaar, which shall act as the Centralized Middleware Enterprise Service Bus for all inter application connectivity. Raj SewaDhaar shall ensure that there are no P2P connectivity systems, also ensuring that services can be utilized by multiple systems on the fly with centralized monitoring.

All OIC must ensure that any new applications under conceptualization or development should use Raj SewaDhaar Middleware Enterprise Service Bus for deployment as well as consumption of services, including web services, API, JSON/REST etc. The system complies with multi format request/response mechanism.

Similarly for legacy applications, migration of all third party linkages through Raj SewaDhaar be ensured by 26<sup>th</sup> January 2016.

The onboarding form for Raj SewaDhaar is available at the portal, <http://sewadhaar.rajasthan.gov.in> which needs to be filled by the respective project OIC to initiate the onboarding process. Once the onboarding form is submitted, the corresponding teams shall ensure onboarding on Raj Sew Dhaar.
